More than 20 clients were given an online equivalency statement, a voucher from WES to be used toward getting their degrees evaluated and a list of accreditation agencies they can pursue if interested in formal credential recognition.

## SPENDING PLANS

The saying "knowledge is power" may be viewed as a well worn cliché, but it is still very relevant today. Financial terms can be confusing for many of us. What you need is a common sense approach of taking control of your financial life.

The single most important action you can take to protect yourself, both against poor financial management and against unforeseen "negative life events" is to create and maintain a **Spending Plan**.

Any spending plan must always start with a clear understanding of what you spend and where you spend it. It is a

fact that, for most people, significant savings will only occur after a clear understanding of spending is achieved.

The first step is to determine your behaviour as a consumer. First, you need to track your current spending habits so that you can analyze your spending behaviour and determine if there are any problems and, what can be done about those problems.
